602.6 Second Language Programs and Courses other than English and French

Policy

The provision of second language programs and courses other than French and English is permitted.

Regulations

- 1. The decision to provide a second language course other than French or English for which a provincial curriculum exists shall rest with the principal.
- 2. Provision of a second language course for which no provincial curriculum exists requires the development and approval of a locally developed course.
- 3. The proposal to provide a second language program other than French or English shall be made collaboratively by Executive Council and school administration, as appropriate, in consultation with relevant stakeholders. The final decision for implementation of the program shall rest with the Board.
